63 **a Footpath Officer's Report**

Mr Windsor's written report was read:

Having got back from France last Monday I have done one walk from High Halstow back home through St Mary.

The section of RS14 that was of concern to Christoph Bull has for the most part been fully cleared. The remaining section is not as good but is easily passable.

RS31 going north from Britannia Road is becoming overgrown.

RS24 going north from Ratcliffe Highway is overgrown.

RS7 from Shakespeare Farm Road across Dagnam Farm has crops growing over it with no defined route.

All the above have been reported to Adam Taylor.

Members were reminded of the walk to be led by Christoph Bull on 31<sup>st</sup> July.

64      **b      Bus Stop**

Cllrs Budd and Ballard had met Rob Carmen of Medway Council on site. The following day the stop sign had been moved and the road marked.

65      **c      Speed Limits**

Cllr Budd reported he had been in touch with Cllr Filmer and the highways manager. He had received a reply from Chris Rogers. Subsequently there had been an accident at Bush House, where someone had gone into the front wall. This was reported to Mr Rogers and a site meeting with Mr Rogers, Dave Warner, Cllr Ballard and himself had taken place. A scheme would be drawn up involving reflective bollards, chevrons, road markings and signs.

66      **d      Post Box, Fenn Corner**

A representative of Royal Mail had met Cllr Ballard. He had indicated a replacement box was waiting in their depot for installation in the wall at Fenn House Farm when it had been re-built. A discussion about whether to offer to build a brick pillar to house the box followed. It was then agreed to ask Cllr Filmer to approach Royal Mail on the grounds of road safety.

67      **e      Verges**

Cllr Budd said he was trying to ascertain ownership of road verges. He had now established that the verges between Hopper's Lane and Homewards Road belonged to Medway Council and they had agreed to trim them. Cllr Mrs Kelly said she would ask Robert MacLean about trimming some verges. PK

68      **a      Representative's Report**

Cllr Budd reported on the last meeting, which had been hosted by St James, Isle of Grain Parish Council. The police inspector had provided statistics, claiming there had been 40,000 fewer victims over the last 12 years. Cllr Buss had raised the issue of vehicles racing at the roundabouts and had asked what the police were doing about it. The Chairman of Hoo St Werburgh Parish Council said they were congregating at Homeleigh Farm Shop and asked the police to target them. Census statistics had been released. The population in the area had grown by 10% since

2001 but the density was still low. After the meeting they had walked the coastal path. The next meeting was being hosted by Allhallows Parish Council.
