The storage container was discussed. The necessary groundworks would cost about £1,500. It was agreed to arrange for this to be done as soon as possible and then to order the container. Spring bulbs would be planted by Grass Roots.

The cost would be higher than that previously quoted, but all the necessary road orders and permissions would be obtained by Volker Highways and it was felt they had a better understanding of what was required. It was proposed by Cllr Hassell, seconded by Cllr Ballard and agreed to proceed with Volker.
